

Arkansas State Police and the Howard County Sheriff's Office in Southwest Arkansas are looking for a missing child.

Zahkairi Morrison, 18 months old, was last seen with Ralph Morrison, 28.

The little girl is missing from the town of Tollette.

Howard County Sheriff's Office deputies say around 12:30 Sunday afternoon, they received multiple 9-1-1 calls of a car collision and a fight near the area of Buck Eye Street and Silver Street in Tollette.

Deputies say Ralph Morrison III intentionally collided with a car that was occupied by three women and Zahkairi Morrison. Deputies say Ralph Morrison punched, kicked and stabbed Zahkairi's mother with an ice pick. He then forcibly took the girl from her mother and walked away, ice pick still in hand. It is believed he was able to get away from Tollette by riding with several individuals.

It is believed also he could be trying to get to the Texarkana area and possible to California. Warrants have been issued in his name for Kidnapping, Aggravated Assault and Domestic Battery.

Zahkairi has black hair that is braided with colored beads (see photo). The child was last seen wearing sky blue over pink shirt and shorts.

Ralph Morrison has several tattoos including: under left arm pit of a bracelet, left arm, left wrist, right arm, left shoulder, on front right arm and front left arm. His last known address is in Texarkana (Miller County).

The little girl may be traveling in an older Cutlass 4 door sedan. The color and license plate number are not known.

Her mother, Amaria Webster was taken to the hospital with numerous injuries to her neck, shoulder, inner thigh, and other parts of her body. She has since been released from the hospital.
